

Training programme on “Fruits for Livelihood and Economic Security” at KVK-Narayangaon under AMAAS- TSP

A training programme on “Fruits for Livelihood and Economic Security” was held on 20th February 2023 at KVK-Narayangaon under AMAAS- TSP. In this programme 30 farmers belonging to schedule tribe category attended the training meeting and they were given training on “Fruit cultivation for economic and livelihood security” by Dr Nishant Deshmukh, Senior Scientist, ICAR-NRC Grapes. Overall crop protection that needs to be done in fruit crops as well as in field crops and the safe way of handling pesticides were briefed by Dr Sujoy Saha, PI of AMAAS. And from KVK Narayangaon Dr. Dattatray B. Gawade (Subject Matter Specialist- crop protection) talked about drone application as well as application of pesticides in fruit crops as per recommendation. He also talked about scientific production of mushrooms as well as on honeybee keeping. In the programme beneficiaries were provided with inputs like water cans and bio pesticides.
