

Program on Feedback cum Distribution of Fertilizers to SCSP Beneficiaries was organized on 11.03.2024 at Malichinchore Village, Taluka: Newasa, District: Ahmednagar

ICAR–NRCG, Pune had organized the agricultural input distribution cum feedback-interaction meeting at Malichinchore village, taluka Newasa, District Ahmednagar under Scheduled Castes Sub Plan (SCSP) Scheme Govt. of India on 11.03.2024. In this distribution program, various essential fertilizers required for cultivation of agricultural crops were supplied to 115 farmers of Malichinchore village. Dr. Somnath Holkar, (Senior Scientist), ICAR-NRCG, Pune and Nodal officer of the SCSP program, interacted with the farmers of Malichinchore and provided the information about the SCSP program, diseases management approaches and discussed about the various programs implemented in the last three years.
